By entering any exhibit into the show, you are agreeing to the Conditions of Entry of Exhibits To Show as determined by the Show Committee of the French Bulldog Club Of Victoria Inc. The Club will not entertain any correspondence received before or after the Show requesting a change to this Condition of Entry.

Mr. David R. Miller (aka Jean-David Laplanche)

Mr. David R. Miller (aka Jean-David Laplanche) has been a dog enthusiast all his life. From an early age, his parents raised various terriers. In the early Seventies while residing in France since his family is French, he fixed his sights upon many French breeds and the dogs that he has raised for over forty years, Salukis. Under the prefix of Shandell, and coupled with the French Saluki kennel, Arab Bahari, he still occasionally breeds and shows. In addition, he has owned Afghans, Dalmatians and Italian Greyhounds. Mr. Miller has judged French Bulldogs all around the world including specialties in France as well as officiating upon them at the World Dog Show in Shanghai.

In the Mid-Seventies and throughout the Eighties, Mr. Miller showed not only his Salukis, but dogs in several breeds for clients. In 1988, he applied to the American Kennel Club and was approved to judge Salukis. Since then, he has been approved to judge the American Kennel Club Sporting Group, Hound Group, Toy Group, Non Sporting Group, Fourteen Terriers, Five Herding and Three Working breeds. He has held many offices in the Grand River Kennel Club, currently Vice President, and is the cluster chairperson for their cluster weekend – The Regatta Classic. Moreover, he is the Vice President of the Cuyahoga Valley Hound Association and the founder of the Regatta Classic Dog Shows in Ohio.

Mr. Miller has officiated in the capacity of judge in thirty-three countries on six continents. He is published in both English and French in professional educational periodicals as well as dog publications. Moreover, he has given seminars internationally on the Afghan, Azawakh, Saluki, Whippet, Solving the Mysteries of Breed Type, Back to Basics, and Judging Procedure.



He travels frequently to North Africa due to his association with sighthounds and conducts tours of Marrakech, Morocco and its surroundings. As an avid traveler, he has visited many kennels around the world.

Professionally, Mr. Miller, retired, was the Department Coordinator of World Languages for a school system in the Cleveland, Ohio Metropolitan Area. He has also instructed on the university undergraduate and graduate levels. He holds a Masters Degree in Education with a specialization in French as well as a Certificat Du Premier Degré from the Université De Strasbourg, France. He is a translator and has conferred on

projects for officials at the United Nations in relation to indigenous canine breeds of the Sahara.

In his spare time, he is a photographer and his work has been published internationally. Mr. Miller speaks French, German, Italian and English.

DOGS VICTORIA REGULATIONS

VCA REGULATIONS 7.4 ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

7.4.3

Every person who enters a dog in any fixture conducted under these regulations shall be responsible for the correctness of the details on the entry forms

VCA REGULATIONS 7.5 PROCEDURES AT EXHIBITIONS

7.5.1

No member of a judge's household, including a person who resides at the same address, shall exhibit or handle any dog at any fixture at which the judge officiates as a judge.

7.5.2

At any exhibition a Ring Steward will not exhibit or handle any exhibit under a judge for whom they have stewarded at that exhibition

7.5.3

No person shall exhibit or handle in any show or exhibition under a judge who has, or has had, a proprietary interest in a dog or dogs whether solely or in partnership with such person, within a period of 12 months prior to such Show or exhibition

7.5.4

No person shall exhibit or handle under a judge, if that judge has handled any dog owned or part owned, leased or part leased by such person within a period of 12 months prior to such event or exhibition. This Regulation applies to approved and sanctioned events, with the exception of dog matches and members competitions and does not apply where an exhibitor assists another exhibitor who, due to a judging decision on the day, is required to compete with two or more exhibits at the same time.

7.5.5

No person shall exhibit or handle under a judge, if that person has handled any dog owned or part owned, leased or part leased by such Judge within a period of 12 months prior to such event or exhibition. This Regulation applies to approved and sanctioned events, with the exception of dog matches and members competitions and does not apply where an exhibitor assists another exhibitor who, due to a judging decision on the day, is required to compete with two or more exhibits at the same time

7.5.6

No person shall exhibit or handle under a judge if that person has billeted that judge or been billeted by that judge in a period of six months prior to a show at which the judge is officiating or intends to billet the judge within 24 hours after the show

7.11.20

A judge shall not enter, exhibit or handle any dog at any show or other exhibition where that judge is appointed to judge
